ITALY WITH KELLY TOURS

SCHEDULE

PASSPORT REQUIRED

May 8&9: Fly from Charleston or Savannah to Milan Italy. This will require a noon departure from the school via motorcoach to check in for the overnight flight to Italy's Milan Airport. Upon arrival, the students will clear Italian customs, enter the EU, and begin their adventure. Explore Milan's top attractions on a walking tour. Led by a guide, visit the Duomo di Milano, Italy's largest church, and enjoy a visit to Leonardo da Vinci's 'The Last Supper'. Students will begin to understand local Italian customs, and money exchange, and have time for lunch at one of the beautiful plazas in the city center. This afternoon we transfer via motorcoach to Mestre for two nights.

May 10: A European breakfast is served daily on this trip. This is a combo of meats, cheeses, fruits, pastries, cereals, and eggs. Today's unique tour includes the water taxi into Venice where a local guide will meet the group for a walking tour. A tiny collection of islands-turned-onetime maritime empire, Venice is one of Italy's most enigmatic and fascinating destinations. On our in-depth Venice walking tours of St. Mark's Basilica, the Doge's Palace, the Rialto Market and beyond, our expert guides will bring all 1,600 years of Venetian history and heritage to life. The day will end with free time to enjoy the street artist along San Marco Square and a sunset boat ride back to our bus to return to the hotel.

May 11: Say Buongiorno! Today we visit the "glass island" of Murano and the "lace island" of Burano. Via boat, the group will transfer along the Grand Canal for a day of exploration. Students will observe glass blowing and the art of lacemaking and all the time a local guide will be showing the way. This afternoon we return to the mainland with Venice in the rearview. Dinner is special, a cooking class! Students will learn to cook three typical dishes of the Italian tradition, using professional tricks and techniques. Bon Appetite!

May 12: Board the coach and continue to Tuscany. We will have a rest break in Padua and a lunch stop in Bologna and arrive at a hotel near Florence this afternoon. We climb Piazzale Michelangelo for a glorious view of the city skyline and no other greater spot to watch the sunset in this carnival atmosphere. Later a pasta dinner is waiting at a local trattoria.

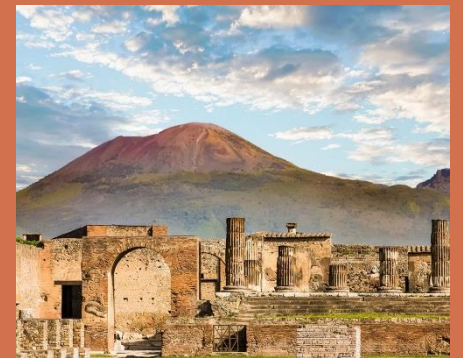
May 13: Florence is a walking city, and we enjoy the many sites of the city with a local guide leading the way. The Medici Grand Dukes, the Renaissance, and World War II History will be included today as we cross the Arno River into the city. All the city sights will be covered with a visit to the Academia, home of Michelangelo's David statue. Lunch and dinner are on your own today and there are many options to choose from. Return to the hotel this evening and ready ourselves for the Eternal City of Rome.

May 14: A beautiful drive thru Tuscany includes a stop at the hilltop city of Montepulciano for a rest break and we arrive in Rome this afternoon for a two-night stay. This evening dinner is included at Piazza Navona. Surrounded by outdoor cafes, this square is magnified during the evening with its three fountains. Street artists abound pedaling their crafts and performing. Relax and soak up the ambiance and beauty, but don't forget a gelato or maybe a specialty from Tre Scalini Gelateria!

May 15: We begin the day at the Vatican for a guided tour through the Sistine Chapel to experience Michelangelo's painted ceiling and St. Peter's Basilica. Next, the Roman Forum, a giant archeological park where ancient Romans formed government, celebrated victories, and created business daily, it has been called the most celebrated meeting place in the world. Adjacent is the Roman Colosseum built in 70AD, where gladiators once roamed, and 50 to 80 thousand spectators could be seated in this world's largest amphitheater. Other sites include the Trevi Fountain and the Spanish Steps.

May 16: Today we board one of the direct trains to Pompei for a visit into the lives of the ancient Roman elite. Buried in volcanic ash in 79 A.D., the former resort town of Pompeii is now fully excavated and, uniquely preserved as it was, one of the world's richest archaeological sites. Later, our bus and luggage rejoin us, and we transfer to our hotel for one last night. Special pizza dinner, where the pie is said to have been first created, tonight in Naples to celebrate our farewell dinner.

May 17: Transfer early to the Naples airport for the return flight to the USA.

HOW PARENTS CAN SIGN UP THEIR STUDENT
