Pura Vida! is how the friendly Ticas greet guests to their country. The country is a little larger than the state of South Carolina and so diverse! This six-day travel program is action-packed and will combine the beautiful Pacific coast with the rain forest and mountainous regions of the country. Costa Rica enjoys a year-round mild temperature with Spanish as the main language. It is an international destination for travelers from all over the world, but English and the US dollar are accepted everywhere. The food is fantastic and will be a highlight of the tour. Pura Vida to Costa Rica is a way of life (Pure Life) and the phrase has become their culture. Costa Ricans use this term to say hello, goodbye, or even to let people know everything's good! As you visit this unique and diverse country, you too will be joining in with the phrase and hopefully bring a little souvenir of Pura Vida home with you.

INCLUDES: Roundtrip flights, meals as listed, lodging as listed, programs and activities as listed, Kelly Tours tour director, snack and drink, travel arrangements, and all taxes.

April 20: Morning flight to Costa Rica. After clearing passport control, a motorcoach will transfer our group to Tamarindo for a two-night stay on the Pacific. The remainder of the day is for relaxing and adjusting after travel. Dinner is included, with El Casado, a typical Costa Rican meal served with your choice of protein, beans, rice, salad, and plantain. Be careful with the condiments, as some are rather picante! Afterward, music and Latin dance lessons are included.

April 21: Breakfast is included each day in Costa Rica and even though the meal may vary, there will be plenty of fruit, bread, juices, eggs, meat, and great coffee that is grown locally. Today, students will participate in a community service project. Details of the project will be provided closer to the tour. We return to the hotel this afternoon for a refresher before an evening catamaran cruise to a deserted beach with dinner and a wonderful sunset over the Pacific! Costa Rica is close to the equator, so the sun rises about 5:30am and sets about 6pm year-round. Tomorrow we are off to the cloud forest!



SCHEDULE CONTINUED

April 22: After breakfast, we load the bus for a thrilling ride up to 5000 feet above sea level to the Cloud Forest and Monteverde. Travelers will enjoy a chocolate tour this morning as you learn the history of chocolate in Costa Rica and even enjoy a taste! Arriving in Monteverde this afternoon for 1-night. The temperature will change as will the flora and fauna, so be prepared to wear comfortable closed toe shoes and a light rain jacket, as it rains off and on daily in the cloud forest. Monteverde is a cool little mountain town with shops and restaurants. Dinner is included, followed by a night tour armed with only a flashlight, students will get in touch with nature and interact with the Cloud Forest's biodiversity. A professional guide will instruct you on the mysteries and curiosities of the rain forest after dark.



April 23: Breakfast is included. Today's highlight includes a guided tour of the Selvatura Park's Forest. The forest is loaded with wildlife including over 500 different species of birds, 4 types of monkeys, the three toed sloth, and reptiles. Starting off with a 2 kilometer walk along the forest floor and across 8 different suspension bridges, students will study the biodiversity of this one of kind rain forest. Next is a thrill of the lifetime, 15 different zip lines from 18 different viewing platforms that stretch over 3 kilometers. Safety is number one as professional guides fit everyone with harnesses and helmets and teach students the proper technique for riding the cables. Also included during the visit to Selvatura Park is a visit to the sloth sanctuary. These loveable creatures arrived having been rescued and are living in a natural habitat. In close collaboration with the Caribbean Sloth Sanctuary, Selvatura Park showcases the sloth, one of Costa Rica's most iconic animals. 20 sleepy, slow-moving, tree-dwelling individuals. This is the sanctuary where time takes on a new meaning and invites quiet contemplation of these extraordinary mammals. We travel this afternoon to Guanacaste for a two-night stay.



April 24: Breakfast is included. Today we visit the Rincon de la Vieja National Park and enjoy several experiences. First, a nature walk with views of the volcano and a chance to enjoy the thermal pools and mud baths. Students will also enjoy tubing down the Rio Negro. This three-mile ride has both rapids and calm pools of crystal-clear water. This evening is highlighted by a farewell celebration dinner and fire show!

April 25: Breakfast and a relaxing morning before transferring to the Airport for the flight back to the states. Don't forget that a passport is required for this trip! We arrive back after a trip that will provide great memories for years to come.

WAITLISTS

Availability is based on a first-come first-serve basis. If there are no available spots, travelers may be placed on a waiting list. Kelly Tours buses accommodate 50 passengers (including the chaperones and escort). An additional bus may be added to the trip (at the discretion of the school and Kelly Tours) if the waiting list exceeds 20 people by the final payment date. *Some tours may be limited by special program availability, by the school or group leader. In these cases, registration will be based on a first-come first-serve basis.

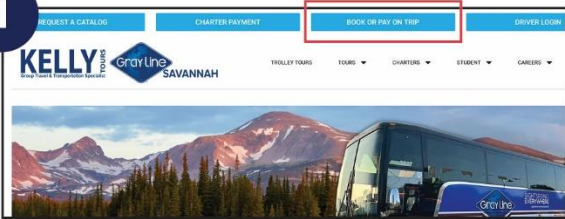

6. Once a payment plan is chosen, they fill out their payment information using our secure payment window, review the tour information, and approve their student's booking.

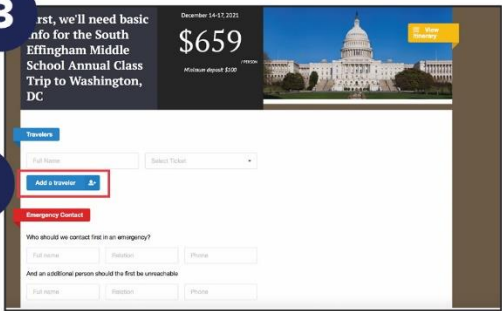
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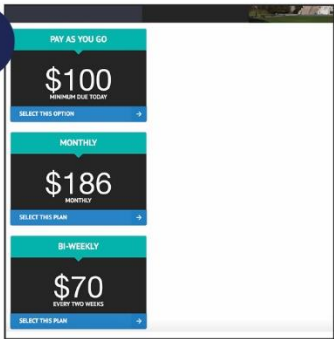
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
